

The BANCROFT RANCH

RATE SHEET (Updated May 2022)

FACILITIES. Bancroft Ranch has safe and comfortable accommodations for your equine friend.

- All paddocks have a 12x12 shelter, rubber floor and are set up so no one eats directly off the ground. The paddocks vary in size from 40'x50' to 60'x135' and are fenced corral board covered with no-climb safety fence. NO WINTER MUD.
- Facilities also include a 100'x200' all-weather arena, a 45' round corral, safe and sturdy hitching posts, individual tack closets, wash rack and access to private trails.

REGULAR CARE. Includes standard feeding* and holding for vet or farrier. Seasonal blanketing is provided on an as-needed basis, charged at \$2 per time (both on and off).

- \$600 Large Paddock (minimum size 40' x 50')

RETIREMENT CARE. Bancroft Ranch offers compassionate care for your retiree in your absence. Includes daily inspection, grooming as needed, and holding for vet or farrier. Feeding for retired horses includes all feedstuffs as required.

- \$650 Large Individual Paddock

SHORT TERM BOARD

- \$200 per week or \$30 per day. Horses must be current on all vaccines.

STANDARD FEEDING

- Standard feeding includes high quality grass or grass/alfalfa hay and feeding of any dry supplements provided by client. Wet supplements (oil, drenches) cost \$30/mo. Fresh water and trace mineral salt blocks are always available.
- Feeding for retired horses additionally includes shredded hay, hay cubes, alfalfa, alfalfa pellets, complete pellets or senior feed as required.

OUTSIDE SERVICES

- Outside trainers must provide proof of liability insurance. An arena fee of \$10 per rider per hour will be assessed.
- Mobile veterinary services are provided by Steinbeck Country Equine Clinic in Salinas 831-455-1808. Any other vets need to be scheduled and attended to by owner.
- Farrier services are provided by DJ Fiske from Salinas (cell 209-617-7390, mailing address 59 Vista Drive, Salinas CA 93907). His 2022 rates are trim \$65, shoes \$225 and half set \$160. Corrective and specialty work costs more. Any other farriers need to be scheduled and attended to by owner.
